**eMule collection** is an open [file format](#) used to describe links to files for uploading using the [eDonkey](#), [Gnutella2](#), [HTTP](#), [FTP](#), and other protocols.

The format is mainly intended for use in eDonkey networks. The format has text and binary versions.

The text version of the format consists of [ed2k links](#), the format of which allows you to specify HTTP sources. The binary version allows you to save comments, ratings, and subscribe collections in collections. eMule collections do not have a tree structure, as, for example, in the [Direct Connect sublist format](#).

The [Shareaza](#) multiprotocol client supports this format, and thanks to its protocol features, it can find alternative sources using the [Gnutella2](#) network.
